Index calculation	<p><b><i>The secrecy score should only be used for the OECD dashboard and excluded from the calculation of the Index</i></b></p> <p>Instead of being used only for generating the OECD dashboards, the variable “secrecy score” was also used for the calculation of the score on SDG Goal 17 for all countries for which data were available (including OECD countries and other countries).</p>
Index calculation	<p><b><i>The global slavery Score was not included in the calculation of the Index when it should have been.</i></b></p>
p.412	<p><b><i>The indicator “expected years of schooling” should be labelled “mean years of schooling”</i></b></p>
p.476	<p><b><i>Labelling issue with the indicator on “patent applications filed under the PCT in the inventor’s country of residence (per million population)</i></b></p> <p>The indicator reported does not correspond to the number of patents filled to the PCT but rather to the number of triadic patent families (defined as a set of patents registered in various countries (i.e. patent offices) to protect the same invention) filed at three of these major patent offices: the European Patent Office (EPO), the Japan Patent Office (JPO) and the United States Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO).</p>
