1. Education, Gender and Inequality

Early childhood development, Primary & secondary education, Vocational training & higher education, Social protection system and labour standards, Research & development

2. Health, Well-Being and Demography

Universal health coverage, Healthy behaviours and social determinants

3. Energy Decarbonization and Sustainable Industry

Access to clean energy, Zero-carbon electricity generation, Energy efficiency, Electrification and zero-carbon fuels, Curbing pollution

4. Sustainable Food, Land, Water and Oceans

Efficient and resilient agricultural systems, Protection of terrestrial and marine biodiversity, Healthy food promotion and regulation, Trade and supply chains consistent with sustainable Development, Integrated land-use and water management

5. Sustainable Cities and Communities

Urban access to water, sanitation, and waste management, Sustainable mobility and transport networks, More compact settlements, Urban adaptation and resilience

6. Digital Revolution for Sustainable Development

Universal broadband and IT infrastructure, Digital inclusion, skills, privacy protection, and universal identity, Mobilizing digital technologies to achieve all SDGs
